eonardo Da Vinci's painting of Mona Lisa and the mask of a young woman known as Ko-omote from the traditional Japanese Noh Theater were both created at about the same time. Both are famous artworks that have fascinated people with their subtle and charming smiles. On one hand, people appreciate an Italian Renaissance painting of a beguiling woman. On the other hand, people find mysterious beauty in a Muromachi period mask of a young maiden. Both are starting points for discovering the beauty of Eastern and Western art. The Noh mask maker and sculptor Yamaguchi Bidou reinterprets Western-style paintings of beautiful women through traditional techniques used to make Noh masks. Combining both traditions, he creates masks "persona" that are a completely new fusion of Eastern and Western cultures.
